Centerline Liberties Launches Ad Campaign Highlighting Support for The Freedom to Marry

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Today, Centerline Liberties launched a digital advertising campaign reinforcing what we know from [public polling](#), [legislative action](#), and [public statements](#) - that the freedom to marry is settled law. The ad highlights President Donald Trump’s support for the freedom to marry, and spotlights how marriage contributes to stronger families and communities across the board.



The thirty-second spot emphasizes more than 800,000 same-sex couples are married in the United States and 300,000 children are being raised by same-sex couples, making clear that protecting the freedom to marry is essential to America’s foundation and a more secure future.

“The Supreme Court’s 2015 ruling on the freedom to marry has strong, bipartisan majority support across the nation, including from President Trump,” said **Centerline Liberties Senior Advisor Dave Whalen**. “As the numbers repeatedly show, the freedom to marry has allowed all Americans to love, live and create a stronger America and must remain settled law.”

“What President Trump said in 2016, remains true today: the Freedom to Marry is settled in the U.S.,” added **Centerline Liberties Founder and Board President James Dozier**. “The freedom to marry is essential in supporting stronger and healthier American families and communities.”
